

CROP STAGE -

• Ranging from replant areas yet to emerge through to 9 nodes and starting to square. Replant mostly due to rain during irrigation shifts or taildrain water backup overtopping rows. Crop growth has been slow. Heat of recent days will help although strong winds affecting some crops.

INSECTS/BENEFICIALS -

- Pest pressure generally low.
- Some thrips pressure causing leaf distortion due to slow growth rate.
- Mirids in some crops causing tip damage
- Helicoverpa eggs present but no damage.

WEEDS -

- Pendimethalin has grass weeds (incl FTR) under control.
- OTT glyphosate applications have commenced along with cultivations

DISEASE -

• Minor though some presence with cool (and occasionally wet) conditions.

GENERAL COMMENTS -

- One of the slowest starts I've seen with cotton crops
- Some replant on roughly 20% of farms.






