















On average all locations are running at 12 % above the 10-year average for day degrees.











Crop check 15th December

Crop stage

- 8 to 15 nodes
- Most at 12 14 nodes
- Majority fruiting at node 6 to 8
- Replant 3 nodes
- Most fields two nodes ahead of last season

Insects/Beneficals

- The odd mirid present but still quiet
- Odd hot spots of flea beetles
- High beneficial/predatory numbers

Weeds

- High pressure after wet seasons and flooding
- Up to 2nd glyphosate application

Disease

Soil pathogen impact has eased with the heat

General Comments

- Tracking well
- Hail damage in some crops
- Rapid growth rates in some crops, 3 nodes in a week
- First mepiquat applications are being planned
- Some light to major herbicide drift damage
- Heat seeing crops pick up where water timing has been good
- Could see first flowers by Xmas <u>CSD | Simulated time to estimated first flower</u>
